













RULES OF PLAY - Golf Canada (R.C.G.A.) rules govern play except where modified by local rules.

OUT OF BOUNDS - defined by white stakes.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR - include material piles for removal, new mounding or disturbed areas under the care of the Superintendent, even if not marked. Relief is granted to the player. (Rule 25)

ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS / NEW DEVELOPMENT AREAS – are defined as native or natural areas that contain: non-irrigated areas, fescue, wetland and any undisturbed terrain that support native wildlife in addition to fencing or other formal barriers. Players must obey all signage or notification methods presented. Ball retrieval is not endorsed for your safety. Please play under the lateral hazard procedure. (Rule 26)

DRESS GUIDELINES – is casual clothes suitable for conditions.

MUSIC GUIDELINES – open air music will be permitted after players have left their first tee and allowed until play on the final hole is concluded, with volume not to exceed 15 vards from the cart.

ALCOHOL - must be purchased from The Links at Brunello as outside alcohol is not legally permitted.

POWER CARTS – are required to be kept 30 yards from greens or as communicated through the GPS system and are to remain on cart paths at all tee areas. The course determines the access privilege to fairways as weather and conditions dictate.

PACE OF PLAY – the equal effort of the golfer and The Links at Brunello is that a reasonable pace of play is targeted at no more than 4 hours 30 minutes. Players are expected to keep pace with the groups ahead while maintaining a safe environment for each. The Links at Brunello encourages "Hit When Ready" play and that faster groups play through

BALL FLIGHT / POWER CART - all players are solely responsible for any and all damage or injury that is caused from their golf ball and the operation of the assigned power cart.

GOLFERS CONDUCT – all players are to instinctively repair ball marks, use sand and seed as needed to fill divots and rake bunkers. Players following say "thank you".

POWER CARTS / NATURE - we say, "Green means Go" (fairway / maintained rough) and "Brown means No" (natural areas, fescue, wetland and non-maintained areas).
