The Turf Care Specialist will perform specific techniques and practices that are required to uphold one of Canada's top golf courses. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Turf Care

- Greet any fellow employees and guests you encounter with a smile
- Keep all equipment and work areas clean and safe and in proper working order at all times
- Mow greens, tees, collars, aprons, fairways and rough
- Perform daily bunker maintenance
- Golf course setup including setting tees, location markers, and cutting pins
- Prepare divot mixes and divot the golf course.
- Move and replace cart control barriers as necessary
- Perform cart path maintenance as necessary
- Any type of manual labour required in maintaining the golf course and renovation projects
- Report all findings of dry spots, diseases, weeds, insects and any other areas of concern
- Operate equipment including specialized equipment safely following procedures
- Maintain fuel and fluid levels for all types of maintenance equipment on a daily basis
- Keep all equipment and work areas clean and in proper working order at all times
- Return all equipment to the designated location in the maintenance building once it has been properly cleaned
- Report equipment problems or failure to the Head Mechanic immediately
- Any other duties as assigned

2. Health and Safety

- Every individual in our workplace has the responsibility to participate in identifying OHS problems, seek solutions and follow established policy and procedures
- Take every reasonable precaution in the circumstances to protect the employee's own health and safety and that of other persons at or near the workplace
